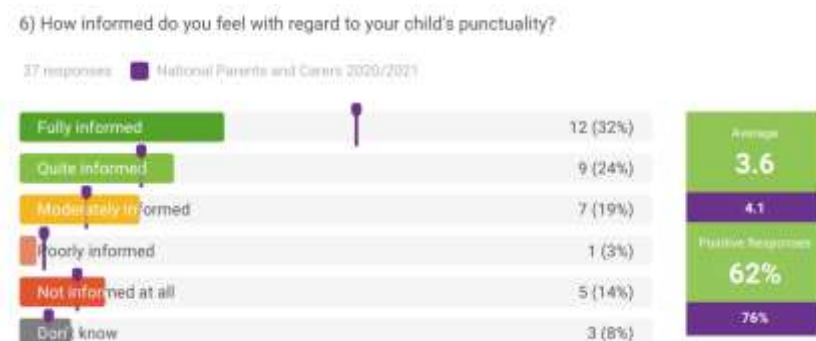
Number of respondents: 32 = 49% of families (assuming one parent from each family responded).

The question on the survey relating to punctuality was as follows:



You will know if your child arrives on time in the morning for school. If we are concerned that your child is regularly late, then Miss Geeson will speak with you personally.

Playtimes during the day follow a pattern which all children are familiar with, so returning to lessons late is not an issue; if there was, we would be in touch with you.

We therefore don't see the need on reporting punctuality to you, other than in the annual school report, as we'd most likely be same thing each time! Please tell us if you think differently.
